IT IS ORDERED that Harris County may accept a check totaling **\$30,000.00** from Saul Ortega and/or his insurer, in consideration of Harris County's release of Harris County's claims against them for workers' compensation related benefits paid on behalf of Harris County's employee arising from the facts made the basis of the above referenced matter.

IT IS ORDERED that after receipt of a check made payable to Harris County in the total amount of **\$30,000.00**, the Harris County Attorney or one of his Assistant County Attorneys may sign a release of Harris County's claims against Saul Ortega and his insurer.

IT IS ORDERED that all Harris County officials are authorized to do any and all things necessary or convenient to accomplish the purposes of this order.
