The Harris County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) respectfully requests authorization from Commissioners Court to approve this commitment for a contribution in the amount of \$2,115,000 per year to The HARRIS CENTER for Mental Health and IDD in connection with the Joint Processing Center (JPC) and Outpatient Competency Restoration (OCR). This contribution is being provided to satisfy the match requirements associated with the application for the FY 2025 Community Mental Health Program.
