

AGREEMENT

This contract and agreement (“Agreement”) is made and entered into between **Harris County**, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, called “County”, and **Cypress Falls H.S. Air Force Junior ROTC**, called “Organization”.

The State of Texas, through its “Adopt a State Highway” program, has successfully established a cleanup program for state highways; and,

It is only fitting that Harris County be the leader among Counties in this State by supporting an “Adopt a County Road” program to keep Harris County roadways free of garbage and other debris and to involve the public in pursuit of a litter free environment; and,

Organization agrees that these goals are furthered by “Adopting a County Road” and desires to join this program.

In consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements, and benefits, both Parties, Harris County and **Cypress Falls H.S. Air Force Junior ROTC**, enter into this Agreement to “Adopt a County Road.”

I.

Organization agrees to perform a general cleanup of the roadsides and medians of **Huffmeister Road beginning at White Oak Ridge Drive and ending at Highway 6 for approximately one mile**. The term of this Agreement begins **November 1, 2022** and ends **October 31, 2024** (“Term”).

The term “general cleanup” includes, but is not limited to, picking up papers, cans, bottles, wood, and other similar types of refuse and litter; placing litter in adequately sized plastic garbage bags, furnished by Organization; and placing these bags near the “Adopt a County Road, Precinct No. 3” signs but at a safe distance from the shoulder of the road, for collection by the County.

Organization agrees to comply with any safety measures the County prescribes. These measures include, but are not limited to, wearing safety vests provided by the County through Precinct 3; performing a general cleanup only after traffic-control signs have been supplied by the County through Precinct 3 and have been set up by Organization; and viewing the Adopt a Highway of the Texas Department of Transportation-Safety Video, provided on the Adopt a Highway website, <http://www.txdot.gov/inside-txdot/get-involved/volunteer/adopt-a-highway/safety-tips.html>, before each cleanup event.

Organization agrees to only perform a general cleanup during the Term of this Agreement. Organization agrees to keep the County informed of the progress of its general cleanup and to contact the County, through its designated representative, whenever a cycle of work is to begin. Additionally, Organization agrees to develop a functional plan, approved by the County, to influence and encourage the public to improve the appearance of the adopted County road. Organization agrees to cooperate with the County in securing appropriate media coverage of the "Adopt a County Road" program.

II.

LTC Chris Echols (Ret.) ("Sponsor") agrees that he will ensure that all participants from the Organization adhere fully to the requirements and terms of this Agreement. Sponsor agrees that he will be the designated representative for communications with the County regarding this Agreement.

III.

The County agrees to do the following:

1. Remove trash bags placed on the designated roadway by Organization, for disposal in an appropriate manner.
2. Supply Organization with the necessary number of safety vests to be worn by its members when carrying out every scheduled general cleanup under this Agreement. Upon completion of every scheduled general cleanup under this Agreement, Organization agrees to return the vests to the County within two working days.
3. Erect signs, facing each direction of traffic, at the beginning and ending point of the portion of road covered by this Agreement or as near as may be practicable due to applicable regulations and conditions. The signs inform the public of Organization's agreement to adopt a county road and will say, "Adopt-A-County Mile, Precinct 3 – Cypress Falls H.S. Air Force Junior ROTC". All signs installed under this Agreement must conform to the "Manual on Uniform Control Devices for the Streets and Highways," as adopted by Harris County.
4. Provide safety information.

IV.

The Parties expressly agree and understand that the work is done and performed by Organization and its members as volunteers under the sole supervision, management, direction and control of Organization, in accordance with the provisions set out here. The County and the Precinct look to Organization for results only and neither the County nor the Precinct has a right at any time to direct or supervise Organization or its members in the performance of their work, or as to the manner, means and method by which the work is performed. The individuals

participating in the cleanup activities are volunteers, whether students or adults. These persons are not employees of the County or of the Precinct through their participation in the cleanup activities and serve no employment function to the County or to the Precinct. However, these persons are entitled to all rights and privileges generally accorded to volunteers under County and Precinct policies.

V.

Organization acting on behalf of itself and its members, agrees to exercise all reasonable care and caution while carrying out cleanup activities. Organization agrees to abide by all applicable state, federal, and local laws, ordinances and regulations. Organization further agrees that all adults participating in any activity under this Agreement will sign a copy of the attached *Release of Liability for Adults* form. Organization further agrees that all minors participating in any activity under this Agreement will have their parents or legal guardian sign a copy of the attached *Parent's Consent and Release of Liability for Minor Child* form. Organization recognizes that execution of these releases is a condition of participation in these activities.

VI.

The County contemplates performing its obligations out of its current budget for the maintenance of roads in County Commissioner, Precinct 3, in which the designated road is located. Notwithstanding anything to contrary, in the event of County's default, Organization's sole and exclusive remedy is to terminate this Agreement.

VII.

Any notice permitted or required to be given to Organization by the County may be given by certified United States mail, return-receipt requested, postage pre-paid, addressed as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that the County Judge be, and is, authorized to execute for and on behalf of Harris County, an Agreement to "Adopt a County Road" between **Harris County** and **Cypress Falls H.S. Air Force Junior ROTC** in connection with the "Adopt a County Road" program to keep Harris County roadways free of garbage and other debris and to involve the public in the pursuit of a litter free environment, said Agreement being incorporated by reference for all purposes as though fully set out in this Order word for word.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR ADULTS

I release Harris County from all claims of any character, type or description as a result of any injury to myself or to my property as a result of any acts arising out of my participation in the "Adopt a County Road" program to perform cleanup activities along the roadsides of **Huffmeister Road from White Oak Ridge Drive to Highway 6 for approximately one mile for a period beginning November 1, 2022 and ending October 31, 2024.** I further recognize and understand that these cleanup activities are under the direction of **LTC Chris Echols (Ret.)**. Harris County is not responsible for supervision, management, direction, and control of the cleanup activities undertaken by **Cypress Falls H.S. Air Force Junior ROTC**. I understand that I am required to view the Adopt a Highway of the Department of Transportation-Safety Video, provided on the Adopt a Highway website, <http://www.txdot.gov/inside-txdot/get-involved/volunteer/adopt-a-highway/safety-tips.html>, prior to each clean up event. I, therefore, agree to release and hold Harris County harmless from all claims of any character, type, or description as a result of any injury to myself or to my property because of my participation in the "Adopt a County Road" program.
