**THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY
AND INJURY MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION, INC.**

This Third Amendment to the Agreement (“Master Agreement”), is made and entered into by and between Harris County (“County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, acting by and through its Department of Human Resources and Risk Management (the “Department”), and Injury Management Organization, Inc. (“Contractor”). The County and Contractor are referred to herein collectively as the “Parties” and individually as a “Party.”

Recitals

On April 8, 2014, the County and Contractor entered into a Master Agreement (the “Agreement”) for workers’ compensation claims administration services for the Department in accordance with Request for Proposal for Job No. 13/0371 (“Services”).

On December 15, 2020, the Parties amended the Agreement for the first time (“First Amendment”) to extend the Agreement for an additional one year term.

On February 22, 2022, the Parties amended the Agreement for the second time (“Second Amendment”) to extend the Agreement for an additional seven (7) month term and add additional funding.

The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement for a third time (“Third Amendment”) to extend the term of the Agreement and add additional funding.

Terms

I.

This Third Amendment shall be governed by the Agreement, First Amendment, and Second Amendment, which are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth word for word.

II.

The Parties agree to add a renewal term to the Agreement. The additional term will begin on October 1, 2022 and end on July 31, 2023.

III.

The total amount appropriated for the additional renewal term will be Two Hundred Thirty

Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$230,625.00). All other terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as originally written and subsequently amended.

IV.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Agreement, First Amendment, and Second Amendment are incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Agreement, First Amendment, or Second Amendment, this Third Amendment shall control.

V.

EXECUTION

Multiple Counterparts: This Third Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Third Amendment.
