IT IS ORDERED that Harris County, Texas owes Creig Cox the total sum of \$40,000.00 of which \$9,446.00 was deposited into the registry of the Court. Harris County will pay the additional \$30,554.00 as just compensation for a drainage easement to the 0.0808 acres (3,518 square feet) and a 14-month temporary construction easement to the 0.0779 acres (3,393 sf) needed for the Cedar Bayou East & West Subdivision Improvement Project located in Precinct 2. This payment represents \$356 for the 14-month temporary construction easement and \$39,644.00 for the drainage easement
