THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND THE RAND CORPORATION

This Third Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, acting by and through the Department of Economic Equity and Opportunity (the "Department"), and The RAND Corporation dba The RAND Policy Research Corporation ("Contractor"), a California nonprofit corporation. The County and Contractor are referred to herein collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

Recitals

On February 21, 2023, the County and Contractor entered into an Agreement (the "Master Agreement") to monitor and provide scientifically rigorous evaluation of the short-and-long-term causal impacts of funded initiatives for the Harris County Early Childhood Impact Fund (the "Services").

On October 31, 2023, the County and Contractor amended the Master Agreement for the first time (the "First Amendment") to change the schedule of distribution of funds for monitoring and evaluation of the short-and-long term casual impacts of programs and interventions to be funded by the Early Childhood Impact Fund for the period of February 21, 2023- February 20, 2026, with no increase in the total contract amount.

On January 30, 2024, the County and Contractor amended the Master Agreement for the second time (the "Second Amendment") to rename the Department from the Office of County Administration to the Department of Economic Equity and Opportunity, to reflect County's internal reorganization, such that "Department" references the Department of Economic Equity and Opportunity.

The Parties now desire to amend the Master Agreement for the third time (the "Third Amendment") to extend the term of the Agreement, update the budget in the Best and Final Offer (Exhibit B), and update the Scope of Work (Exhibit C), with no change in the total contract amount.

Contractor warrants and represents that it is willing and capable of providing the services.

Terms

1) CONTRACT CONSTRUCTION

This Third Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement, the First Amendment, and the Second Amendment, which are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth word-for-word.

2) TERM

The Term of the Master Agreement is hereby amended to extend until September 30, 2026.

3) BEST AND FINAL OFFER – EXHIBIT B

The budget in the Best and Final Offer (Exhibit B) of the Master Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the budget attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference.

4) STATEMENT OF WORK – EXHIBIT C

The Statement of Work (Exhibit C) of the Master Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the Statement of Work attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated herein by reference.

5) ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, the First Amendment, or the Second Amendment, this Third Amendment shall control.

All other terms and provisions of the Master Agreement, the First Amendment, and the Second Amendment shall remain in full force and effect as originally written and subsequently amended.

4) EXECUTION, MULTIPLE COUNTERPARTS

This Third Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Third Amendment.

 - b. Prepare and submit quarterly progress memos within 3 months (90 days) of Purchase Order Issuance and ongoing quarterly
