**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
HARRIS COUNTY AND  
NATIONAL CHARITY LEAGUE – WILDFLOWERS CHAPTER**

This First Amendment is made and entered into by and between **Harris County** (“County”) and **National Charity League – Wildflowers Chapter** (“Organization”). The County and Organization are referred to herein collectively as the “Parties” and individually as a “Party”.

*Recitals*

On or about June 28, 2022, the County and Organization entered into an Agreement (CAO File Number 22GEN1634) (“Master Agreement”) in connection with the “Adopt a County Road” program to keep Harris County roadways free of garbage and other debris and to involve the public in the pursuit of a litter free environment.

The Parties have agreed that certain clarifications and revisions to the provisions of the Agreement is required.

The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement for the first time to clarify and revise the Sponsor’s name (“First Amendment”).

*Terms*

I.

This First Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement which is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth word for word.

II.

Section II of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

Laurie Marek or the successor (“Sponsor”) agrees that she will ensure that all participants from the Organization adhere fully to the requirements and terms of this Agreement. Sponsor agrees that she will be the designated representative for communications with the County regarding this Agreement.

III.

The Organization's contact in Section VII of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

IV.

All other terms and provisions of the Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as originally written and subsequently amended.

V.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Master Agreement is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this First Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, this First Amendment shall control.

VI.

Multiple Counterparts: This First Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this First Amendment.
