- Section 1. Approval of Harris County Sports & Convention Corporation 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Operating Budget beginning October 1, 2024. The Board hereby approves the Harris County Sports & Convention Corporation 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Operating Budget beginning October 1, 2024, as shown in the attached Exhibit A.
