

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT HOUSTON**

This Second Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the "County"), acting through the County Judge's Office ("CJO" or "Department"), and The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston ("UTHSCH"), and pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 791.001 – 791.037. The County and the Contractor are referred to herein collectively as "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

Recitals

On November 10, 2020, the County and UTHSCH entered into a Master Agreement (the "Agreement") for services related to the County's COVID-19 Community Spread Survey Program (the "Services").

The Parties extended the Agreement ("First Amendment") for the purpose of extending the term.

The Parties now wish to amend the Agreement a second time ("Second Amendment") to extend the term and close out the Agreement on April 30, 2021.

Terms

I.

This Second Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement and First Amendment, which are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth word for word.

II.

The Parties agree to extend the term until April 30, 2021. UTHSCH will close out the project and provide any remaining work product and Services due to the County prior to April 30, 2021. The County will pay UTHSCH the outstanding balance due UTHSCH for work product or Services due to the County under the Master Agreement. However, no additional funds will be appropriated for completion of the Services. UTHSCH will not perform any further Services after April 30, 2021, nor will the County pay UTHSCH for any Services performed after April 30, 2021.

III.

All other terms and provisions of the Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.

IV.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Master Agreement is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, First Amendment, or any other terms and conditions, this Second Amendment shall control.

V.

Execution. Multiple Counterparts: This Second Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Second Amendment.
