A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HARRIS COUNTY APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S 2025 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES
SET-ASIDE (TA) CALL FOR PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation issued a call for projects in January 2025 for communities to apply for funding assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA) Program; and

WHEREAS, the TA funds may be used for development of preliminary engineering (plans, specifications, and estimates and environmental documentation) and construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure. The TA funds require a local match, comprised of cash or Transportation Development Credits (TDCs), if eligible. Harris County would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for TA funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HARRIS COUNTY THAT: Harris County supports funding this project(s) as described in the 2025 TA Detailed Application (including the preliminary engineering budget, if any, construction budget, the department's direct state cost for oversight, and the required local match, if any) and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. Harris County is willing and able to enter into an agreement with the department by resolution or ordinance, should the project be selected for funding.

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Precinct 4 2025 TxDOT TA Grant Application Synopsis

On January 3, 2025, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) announced a statewide Call for Projects for the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA) program for bicyclist and pedestrian infrastructure and planning.

Harris County Precinct 4 (Precinct 4) submitted a Pre-Application in February for the Clay Road Sidewalks and School Access Project. In April 2025, TxDOT informed Precinct 4 that the project was eligible to move forward to the full application, due June 20.

This project, which will add sidewalks along Westfield Village Drive and Clay Road, is essential to improve pedestrian safety, access, and connectivity. The project will provide safer connections to several schools, including M. Robinson Elementary School, Brosnahan Elementary School, Jack & Sharon Rhoads Elementary School, and Cardiff Junior High School. This project will also provide improved access to several residential neighborhoods and commercial establishments along the project corridor and in the vicinity.

Grant Funds Requested: \$19,300,800

Match Funds Required: \$4,825,200

Total Project: \$24,126,000
