**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND
ROY JORGENSEN ASSOCIATES, INC.**

This Second Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas and acting by and the Harris County Toll Road Authority (“HCTRA”), and Roy Jorgensen Associates, Inc. (“Contractor”), a corporation doing business under the laws of the State of Texas. County and Contractor are known individually as “Party” and collectively as “Parties.”

Recitals

On October 5, 2020, the County entered into an agreement with the Contractor to provide roadway and facility management, inspection and maintenance (Section I) for HCTRA, as detailed in RFP Job No. 20/0039 (the “Agreement”).

On October 30, 2025, the Parties amended the Agreement for the first time (the “First Amendment”) to extend the term and add additional funds.

The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement for the second time (the “Second Amendment”) for purposes of extending the term to allow the County sufficient time to advertise and complete a new long-term procurement for the services and adding additional funds to the Agreement.

Contractor warrants and represents that it is willing and capable of providing the services.

Terms

1) CONTRACT CONSTRUCTION

This Second Amendment shall be governed by the Agreement and the First Amendment, which are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth word for word.

2) TERM

The term of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend until May 31, 2027.

3) LIMIT OF APPROPRIATION

Contractor understands and agrees, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of this Second Amendment, that the total maximum compensation that Contractor may become entitled to for the Services performed under this Second Amendment, and the total maximum sum that the County shall become liable to pay Contractor under this Second Amendment for the Services, shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations

thereof exceed the sum of Eighteen Million and 00/100 Dollars (\$18,000,000.00). Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, or that may be construed to the contrary, the County's liability under the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment is limited to said sum; and when all the funds are expended, Contractor's sole and exclusive remedy shall be to terminate this Second Amendment.

4) ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Agreement or the First Amendment, this Second Amendment shall control.

All other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as originally written and subsequently amended.

5) EXECUTION, MULTIPLE COUNTERPARTS

Execution, Multiple Counterparts: This Second Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Second Amendment.
