WHEREAS, Deaf Awareness Month, celebrated nationally every September, is an opportunity to promote understanding about the Deaf and hard-of-hearing community; and

WHEREAS, the Deaf population includes those who were born profoundly deaf and use American Sign Language (ASL) as their primary means of communication; it also includes individuals with varying degrees of hearing loss who use hearing aids or other forms of hearing amplification and communication methods; and

WHEREAS, people who are Deaf or hard-of-hearing experience unique challenges that significantly impact their daily lives, including lack of access to language services or hearing assistive devices; and

WHEREAS, Harris County is committed to ensuring that deaf individuals have access to the resources and services necessary to lead fulfilling and quality lives; and

WHEREAS, several of the County's Departments, including Public Health, the District Attorney's Office, and Clerk's Office, provide valuable assistance, such as ASL interpreters and hearing devices for the Deaf community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Harris County Commissioners Court hereby respectfully observes the month of September as

DEAF AWARENESS MONTH

to advocate for and promote greater accessibility and inclusion of the Deaf community.
