

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
HARRIS COUNTY AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS MEDICAL BRANCH AT GALVESTON**

This Third Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the "County"), on behalf of the Harris County Sheriff's Office ("HCSO") and The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston ("UTMB"). The County and UTMB are referred to herein collectively as "Parties" and individually as "Party."

Recitals

On or about April 18, 2020, the County entered into an agreement ("Master Agreement") with UTMB to provide laboratory services to process samples collected from individuals in HCSO custody at HCSO facilities.

On or about May 20, 2020 the Parties amended the Master Agreement for the first time ("First Amendment") to add additional support from UTMB to conduct on-site testing for Covid-19 for the Harris County Sheriff's Office.

On or about June 26, 2020 the Parties amended the Master Agreement for the second time ("Second Amendment") to provide testing to other County departments.

The Parties now desire to amend the Master Agreement for the third time ("Third Amendment") to provide additional funding for additional COVID-19 testing and other testing.

UTMB warrants and represents UTMB is willing and able to provide the Services.

Terms

I.

This Third Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement and previous amendments, which are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth word for word.

II.

For additional Services provided in accordance with the Master Agreement and subsequent amendments, the County hereby certifies an additional Four Million and No/Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) in appropriated funds.

III.

UTMB understands and agrees that County may seek reimbursement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"). UTMB agrees to perform the Services in accordance with FEMA's required grant clauses attached to the Master Agreement and incorporated herein by reference.

IV.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Master Agreement and Third Amendment are incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, First Amendment, Second Amendment, or any other terms and conditions, this Third Amendment shall control.

V.

Execution. Multiple Counterparts: This Third Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Third Amendment.


