AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES (On-Call Engineering Services)

WHEREAS, the District and Engineer previously entered into an Agreement for Professional Services ("the Agreement"), dated September 15, 2020, to provide engineering and related services as may be needed for program management services in support of the Little Cypress Creek Frontier Program; and

WHEREAS, the District requires additional engineering and related services as provided under Article 1, Character and Extent of Services; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer is willing to provide the necessary additional engineering and related services for further consideration; and

WHEREAS, the District and the Engineer desire to add rate classifications and increase the existing rate classifications under Article 3, The Engineer's Compensation; and

WHEREAS, the District and the Engineer now desire to increase the Limit of Appropriation by \$390,000.00 to \$1,390,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the District and the Engineer, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, do mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE 3 of the Agreement, entitled, "The Engineer's Compensation," reading:

Within thirty days after execution of this Agreement, the District shall have issued an initial purchase order to the Engineer in the amount of \$250,000.00 to perform services assigned during the term of this Agreement in accordance with the terms hereof. Subject to the Limit of Appropriation under Article 7, the District agrees to pay the Engineer according to the following rates:


Section 1: The recitals set forth in this order are true and correct.
