

WHEREAS, Robert "Bob" Royall Jr., Assistant Chief of Emergency Operations, will retire from the Harris County Fire Marshal's Office on July 31, 2022, after 18 years of service to Harris County and 49 years of public safety service; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Royall started his career with the Houston Fire Department in November 1973 and served in various roles as a Captain with the Houston Hazardous Materials Response Team. In May of 2004, he joined Harris County in the Harris County Public Health Department and ended his career with the Harris County Fire Marshal's Office leading the Emergency Operations Division; and

WHEREAS, after devoting a significant portion of his life and energy to Harris County, Assistant Chief Royall is now looking forward to new adventures, traveling, and spending even more time with his family, particularly his wife of 50 years Cheryl Royall; and
