## SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF HARRIS

This Agreement is executed by and between Harris County (the "County") and Gary Scherer. The County and Gary Scherer are referred to herein collectively as "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

The County engaged in a construction project which led to a contractor damaging Gary Scherer's property. The County is willing to pay Gary Scherer for damages to the property during the period from August 1, 2021, to July 5, 2022 (the "Damages").

WHEREAS, the Parties hereto agree to settle the outstanding issues between them as follows:

## I. Indemnification and Release

By executing this Release in order to receive the benefit of the mutual agreement reached, Gary Scherer is waiving and releasing the County, its Commissioners, officials, employees, agents, and assigns from any and all claims, damages, actions, suits in equity, or causes of action, of whatsoever nature, whether now or not presently known to the Parties because of any matter or thing done or omitted concerning or relating to the issues surrounding the Services, which includes any and all lawsuits, whether pending or in the future, against the County, its Commissioners, officials, employees, agents, or assigns.

## II. Consideration

As full compensation for the benefits of this Release and as compensation for the Damages, the County agrees to pay Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$10,720.00). Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, or that may be construed to the contrary, the County's liability under the terms and provisions of this Agreement is limited to this sum.

### III. Miscellaneous

This instrument, together with the instruments incorporated herein by reference, contains the entire Agreement between the Parties relating to the rights herein granted and the obligations herein assumed. Any oral representations or modifications concerning this instrument shall be of no force or effect. Only a written instrument executed by representatives duly authorized by the governing body or legal representatives of the Parties hereto may amend this Agreement.

This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and any applicable Federal laws, regulations and policies. In the event of any

dispute arising under this Agreement, venue shall be proper in a court of competent jurisdiction in Houston, Harris County, Texas, exclusively.

Nothing herein shall be construed as creating any personal liability on the part of any officer or agent of any public body that may be a party hereto.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this instrument has been executed in duplicate originals, each of equal force, on behalf of the Harris County by a duly authorized representative of Harris County pursuant to the approval of the Harris County Commissioners Court, and by Gary Scherer.
