FIFTH MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND THE CHILDREN'S ASSESSMENT CENTER FOUNDATION

This Fifth Memorandum of Understanding of Short Fiscal Year 2022 (the "SFY 2022 Fifth Memorandum") is entered into as of the 27th day of September, 2022 between Harris County ("Harris County") and The Children's Assessment Center Foundation (the "Foundation").

This Fifth Memorandum shall be governed by and be subject to the Agreement between Harris County and the Foundation effective January 1, 2002, as amended August 6, 2002 and November 4, 2003 (the "Agreement") as set forth in Section 2.04(b) of the Agreement.

Pursuant to Section 11.02 of the Agreement, the Usage Fee is to be set on an annual basis. The Usage Fee for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be \$2,834,600.

Section 2.03(b) of the Agreement, as amended, states:

The Foundation shall be responsible for providing funding for that portion of the Annual Operating Budget for each Fiscal Year set forth on Exhibit B. The Foundation shall fund part of such amounts, as indicated on Exhibit B, directly to Harris County, and Harris County shall be responsible for the disbursement of such amounts. The Foundation shall be directly responsible for disbursing the balance.

Section 2.04(a) of the Agreement, as amended, states:

If the Foundation desires in any Fiscal Year to make expenditures in addition to the Annual Operating Budget or as permitted by this Agreement or consistent with the Mission Statement, the Foundation shall submit a Memorandum of Understanding to Harris County and the Executive Director setting forth in reasonable detail the purposes and amount of such additional expenditure.

Pursuant to section 2.03(b) and 2.04(a) of the Agreement, the Foundation sets forth the Annual Operating Budget - Exhibit B expenses and the Foundation Expenses for FY 2023 on the attached listing.
