**WHEREAS**, this year, nearly 20,000 women in the United States will be diagnosed with ovarian cancer, which is hard to detect and usually discovered in advanced stages, and therefore, this disease is often deadly for those diagnosed; and

WHEREAS, during Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month, our Nation honors those who are struggling with this dreaded disease, remembers the loved ones we have lost, recommits to ending ovarian cancer and all cancer; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, MD Anderson Launched its MoonShots Program<sup>™</sup> in a comprehensive effort to reduce deaths and transform cancer care significantly. At the MD Anderson Cancer Center, Ovarian Cancer is one of its primary research areas in the MoonShot Program with teams to pursue innovative projects prioritized for the most significant patient impact. MoonShot efforts will help support all cancer research at MD Anderson; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2016, then Vice President Joe Biden re-ignited the Cancer MoonShot Initiative nationally. The Cancer MoonShot Initiative has a goal of cutting the cancer death rate in half, at least, over the next 25 years; and

WHEREAS, the incidence of ovarian cancer has decreased over the last decades as survival rates have increased. Although no standardized screening tests for ovarian cancer have been shown to improve outcomes, the MD Anderson Cancer Center is working to change that. CA-125, a cancer biomarker being studied at MD Anderson, as well as other new biomarkers, are being evaluated as a screening test: now, therefore
