The Harris County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) is a valued partner with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) Joint Operations Program which allows HSI to reimburse your office for certain approved expenses incurred in support of our shared law enforcement goals.

HSI's Joint Operations Program is funded by the Treasury Forfeiture Fund and all requested reimbursements must be directly related to expenses incurred as a result of your participation with HSI. It should be further noted that the incurred expenses will be reimbursed after payment of initial expenses. The reimbursements will come from the Treasury Forfeiture Fund and will be distributed in the following categories and amounts:

HCSO Overtime (Currency and Narcotic Enforcement Team) \$ 52,000.00 HCSO Overtime (Narcotics Enforcement Group) \$ 13,000.00
