SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND SER-JOBS FOR PROGRESS OF THE TEXAS GULF COAST, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE WORKFORCE TRAINING CENTER PROJECT

This Second Amendment is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the "Grantee") and SER-Jobs for Progress of the Texas Gulf Coast, Inc. (the "Subrecipient"). The Grantee and the Subrecipient are known individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Agreement (the "Master Agreement") on September 24, 2019, for the provision of infrastructure improvements for the purpose of the construction of a Workforce Training Center Project, an eligible activity under the rules and regulations regarding CDBG Program Grant Funds (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2022, Commissioners Court approved a First Amendment that amended the Agreement as follows: to revise Exhibit B, Budget, to add \$115,247.52 in CDBG funds to cover construction and related activities, bringing the total amount of funding for this project to \$2,115,247.52.

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend said Agreement to: (i) extend the 18-month construction completion requirement by an additional thirteen (13) months to June 30, 2023, due to unexpected supply chain delays resulting from the COVID 19 pandemic; and (ii) specify Retainage.

NOW THEREFORE, the Grantee and Subrecipient do mutually agree as follows:

<u>TERMS</u>

I.

All references in the Master Agreement to the Completion of Construction being required within 18 months from the start of construction shall be extended by an additional thirteen (13) months (the "Construction Extension Period") such that the Completion of Construction deadline is now June 30, 2023. This allowance of the Construction Extension Period shall be applicable to Article II(D)(5) Completion of Work; Article III Time of Performance; and any other reference in the Master Agreement to Completion of Construction requirement.

II.

Both Parties agree that the Retainage amount is \$205,699.55.

III.

In the event of any conflict between this Second Amendment to Agreement and the original Agreement

(as may have been previously amended), the terms of this Second Amendment shall govern. All other conditions between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.
