RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Section 396.041 of the Texas Transporation Code authorizes county regulations pertaining to Junkyards or Automotive Wrecking and Salvage Yards;

WHEREAS, Harris County Commissioners Court adopted and approved the Ordinance of Harris County, Texas, Regarding Licensing of Junkyards, Automotive Wrecking, and Salvage Yards on September 15, 2009 ("Ordinance") and subsequently adopted and approved amendments to the Ordinance on September 24, 2013, and May 11, 2021;

WHEREAS, Harris County Commissioners Court now desires to further amend the Ordinance to designate the County Engineer with authority to approve applications to operate a junkyard, automotive wrecking, and salvage yard at a location; and

WHEREAS, Texas Transportaion Code § 396.042 provides that before adopting an ordinance under Texas Transportation Code § 396.041, the Commissioners Court must hold a

public hearing at which any interested member of the public may appear and testify at the hearing about the subject of the proposed ordinance;

WHEREAS, Harris County Commissioners Court conducted the public hearing after giving notice as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that amendment of the Ordinance, as attached to this order and incorporated herein for all purposes, is reasonable and necessary to protect the public health, safety, and desires to adopt the Ordinance.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Ordinance of Harris County, Texas, Regarding Licensing of Junkyards and Automotive Wrecking and Salvage Yards, as attached to this order and incorporated herein for all purposes, is amended. All Harris County officials and employees are authorized to do any and all things necessary or convenient to accomplish the purpose of this order.
