THIS RENEWAL AMENDMENT NO. 2 ("Amendment") is entered into and made effective on the first day of March 2022, by and between **The Harris Center for Mental Health and IDD (the "Agency" or "The Harris Center")**, located at **9401 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas 77074**, a Community Center and Agency of the State of Texas, under the provisions of Chapter 534 of the Texas Health and Safety Code Ann., as amended, and **Harris County (the "County")**, a body corporate and politic under the laws of the state of Texas, acting by and through its **Harris County Sheriff's Office ("HCSO" or "County Agency")**, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act , Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 791.001 – 791.030 for the purpose of providing mental health assessment services.

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") on the 23rd day of August, 2022 ("ILA") to provide mental health assessment services through the Agency's CORE Program.

WHEREAS, Parties to this Amendment, acknowledge that the current Agreement is hereby renewed through February 28, 2026, pursuant to the Amendment Provision, with the following additions and modifications unless such has been added by previous amendment. In the event of a conflict between the Terms and Conditions of the original Agreement and this Amendment, the latter shall prevail.

NOW, THEREFORE and in consideration of the foregoing and in further consideration of the mutual benefits, the Parties agree to the following revised terms:

1. The following CORE budget/rates shall apply for the ensuing fiscal year: \$853,600.00.
2. Article 4. Term and Termination section is hereby amended to read as follows.

The Parties agree to renew the Agreement for the term March 1, 2023 through February 28, 2026. In the event the Agency and County are still negotiating, preparing, and/or reviewing the services for renewal on the February 28, 2026 termination date, this Agreement shall automatically extend for ninety (90) days or until such time as a Renewal Agreement is approved by the Harris County Commissioner's Court, whichever comes first.

Except as provided herein, all other terms, conditions and pricing included in the above referenced Agreement previously established and any amendments or renewals pertaining thereto, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


