## SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND PORTER HEDGES LLP

This Sixth Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County ("County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas and PORTER HEDGES LLP ("Counsel"). County and Counsel are known individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties."

## Recitals

On February 22, 2022, the County entered into an agreement with Counsel to provide representation related to construction contract matters and disputes. (the "Master Agreement").

The County and Counsel now desire to amend the Master Agreement to increase funding (the "Sixth Amendment").

Counsel warrants and represents that it is willing and capable to continue providing the Services.

## **Terms**

I.

This Sixth Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth word for word.

II.

Having previously certified funds in the amount of Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$825,000.00), the Parties hereby amend the Master Agreement to provide One Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$150,000.00) in additional funds bringing the total amount of funds certified as available under the Master Agreement to Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$975,000.00). Counsel understands and agrees, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of this Sixth Amendment, that the total maximum compensation that Counsel may become entitled to for the Services performed under this Sixth Amendment, shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations thereof exceed the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$150,000.00). Counsel understands and agrees, said understanding also being of the absolute essence of this Sixth Amendment, that the maximum amount Counsel may become entitled to under the Master Agreement shall not exceed the sum of Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$975,000.00). Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, or that may be construed to the contrary, the County's liability under the terms and provisions of this Sixth Amendment is limited to said sum; and when all the funds so certified are expended, Counsel's sole and exclusive remedy shall be to terminate

this Sixth Amendment.

III.

All other terms and provisions of the Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.

IV.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Master Agreement is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, this Sixth Amendment shall control.

V.

Execution, Multiple Counterparts: This Sixth Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Sixth Amendment.
