SUBJECT: Recommendation by the County Engineer and the Harris County Flood Control District Executive Director that Commissioners Court Approve the Joint Funding Structure between Harris County and the District for the Wilson's Gully Storm Sewer Repair along W132-00-00, Precinct 3.

Dear Court Members:

It is recommended that Commissioners Court approve the Joint Funding Structure for the Wilson's Gully Storm Sewer Repair along W132-00-00, in accordance with the interlocal agreement framework approved by Commissioners Court on March 31, 2015.

This project is a partnership for local drainage improvements which is led by the Uptown Development Authority (UMD) and the City of Houston (COH) with the design completed and in active construction led by the COH and the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone (TIRZ). Additionally, the Precinct will establish any required agreements between UMD and the COH with additional assistance from Harris County Engineering Department in the non-project related task umbrella. This partnership aims to address and rectify issues within the storm sewer system, ensuring the long-term resilience and efficiency of the drainage infrastructure in the Wilson's Gully area. The Flood Control District intends to contribute a maximum of \$700,000 from Bond ID Z-04 towards the cost of construction. Upon completion, this project will be maintained by the COH.

The joint project and funding structure will facilitate more efficient and cost-effective governmental services.
