Does department have internal funding available to reallocate for this purpose? Describe.	Departments typically have unspent funds at the end of the year, but these funds are typically from vacancy savings, and they are actively recruiting deputies to fill vacant positions.
	Constable clerks have the potential to perform the function but would be pulled from essential functions in incident reporting to perform data entry and reporting tasks which is not sustainable. Without additional funding, overtime is required from existing constable clerks to manage the additional scope of responsibilities.
	In addition, the skill set required for crime reporting requires background knowledge of the categorization of crimes (assault, burglary, vandalism, etc.) to report the data accurately which requires additional training and development.

Was this item considered as part of the budget process for the current Fiscal Year? If so, please provide context.	No, this unfunded mandate was not considered as part of the budget process. In June 2023 the Legislature passed HB4879, making the change effective September 1, 2023. OMB was not made aware of this change until after the beginning of Fiscal Year 2024.
