Request to Increase Impoundment Fees

I am respectfully requesting an increase in Livestock Impoundment Fees. I have spoken with Livestock Units for Fort Bend County Sheriff, Montgomery County Sheriff, and Liberty County Sheriff on their current fees. I observe our fees to be less. We utilize numerous tools such as tranquilizing and corral panels which we do not currently charge. We frequently use ROMPUN to tranquilize animals which cost approximately \$60 (15 doses) and the reversal dose cost approximately \$132 (30 doses). On numerous occasions we are not able to contain the animal(s) and it is necessary to tranquilize for the safety of the employee(s) and the public. In addition, it reduces the chance of the target animal being injured which may require veterinarian services (expense). In 2020, we captured 72 cows and 92 horses. We tranquilized approximately 30% of the estray cows. So far in 2021, we have captured 46 cows and 20 horses. Majority of the cows captured this year have been released back to the owner within a week of capture.

The increased fees will assist in off-setting expenses arising from handling estray livestock in Harris County. We retain estray animals for 18 days and unclaimed are auctioned off at a Livestock Sale in conjunction with State Law. Last year (2020), the Livestock Unit received \$8,305 in Impound Fees and \$11,152.50 in Auction Sales. As of February 28, 2021, we have received \$2,660 in Impound Fees and \$7,934.48 in Auction Fees.
