WHEREAS, on October 28, 2019, Harris County Pollution Services Department submitted comments to the TCEQ on the proposed revisions;

WHEAREAS, on May 13, 2020, the TCEQ submitted its SIP demonstration to the EPA, which failed to implement any new RACT; and

WHEREAS, the EPA is proposing to approve the May 13, 2020 TCEQ SIP concerning RACT for the HGB 2008 8-hour ozone standard.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Harris County Attorney is authorized on behalf of Harris County to file comments with the EPA regarding the .May 13, 2020 revisions to the TCEQ State Implementation Plan concerning Reasonable Available Control Technology (RACT) requirements for the Houston-Galveston-Brazoria (HGB) 2008 8- hour ozone National Air Quality Ambient Air Quality Standard.
