## **Background and Discussion:**

In the agreement which was effective March 1, 1994, Harris County agreed to pay The Harris Center an amount as determined by the County's annual budget allocation in 12 equal monthly installments. To assist with cash flow, the agreement has been amended to reflect a single lump sum payment for the last three years.

Approval of this fifth amendment is requested to allow the County to provide The Harris Center a single lump sum payment for their full fiscal year 2021-22 budget allocation of \$22,567,171.

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#### FIFTH AMENDMENT

This Fifth Amendment is made and entered into as of March 18, 2021 between Harris County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas (the "County") and The HARRIS CENTER for Mental Health and IDD, (formerly known as MHMRA of Harris County), a Community Center and Agency of the State of Texas under the provisions of Chapter 534 of the Texas Health and Safety Code Ann., (Vernon 1992), as amended (The "HARRIS CENTER" or "Authority") each referred to herein as "Party" and collectively, the "Parties".

# **BACKGROUND**

In the original Agreement ("Agreement") which was effective beginning on March 1, 1994 and has been renewed each year since, the Authority (now known as The HARRIS CENTER) agreed to provide mental health and mental retardation diagnostic, treatment, and support services to Harris County residents. Harris County agreed to pay the Authority (now known as The HARRIS CENTER) a total of an amount as determined by the County's annual budget allocation to the Authority (now known as The HARRIS CENTER) in twelve (12) approximately equal installments on or before the first day of each calendar month during each year the Agreement was in effect.

In the First Amendment which was effective June 1, 2017, all references to the Authority were changed to reflect the Authority's new name, The HARRIS CENTER; the payment terms for the County's 2017-2018 Fiscal Year were modified; and The HARRIS CENTER's address was updated.

In the Second and Third Amendments, Parties amended the Agreement to modify the dates on which the County paid The HARRIS CENTER during the County's 2018-2019 Fiscal Year and 2019-2020 Fiscal Year, respectively.

The Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to modify the dates on which the County will pay The HARRIS CENTER during the Center's 2021-2022 Fiscal Year.

Accordingly, the Parties agree as follows:

## 1. AMENDMENTS

- 1.1 Amendment to Modify Payment Dates. Section 1.3 (CONSIDERATION) is amended as follows:
  - 1.1.1. Insert the following at the end of Section 1.3: "Notwithstanding the foregoing, during the County's 2021-2022 Fiscal Year (March 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022), the County shall pay The HARRIS CENTER in full a single payment on or before April 30, 2021."

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- 2. Continuation of Existing Agreement. Except for the amendment made in this Fifth Amendment, the Existing Agreement remains unchanged and in full effect.
