Resolution

WHEREAS, the undersigned members of the Harris County Commissioners Court oppose any legislation that may target or be harmful towards transgender children, including efforts that may deny access to health care or interfere with decisions between them and their doctor, and affect their ability to participate in school sports; and

WHEREAS, Harris County, the largest and one of the most diverse counties in Texas, leads through welcoming and ambitious policies that promote opportunity and freedom so that everyone can thrive. For example, in 2019, Harris County Commissioners Court approved adding sexual orientation and gender-identity protections in its nondiscrimination policy. The policy's intent was to promote a positive and safe work environment for Harris County employees that is not only the right thing to do, but also leads to a more diverse and productive workforce; and

WHEREAS, any bills that may seek to prevent physicians and medical care providers from delivering adequate care to transgender children and threatens the licenses of medical professionals who have taken an oath to serve them are harmful. The consequences of this legislation are deep and will have long-lasting physical and psychological impacts on our youth and their families across Texas: now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Harris County Commissioners Court hereby proclaims our opposition to anti-transgender and anti-child bills related to the medical care of transgender children, criminalization of gender-affirming care, and the participation by transgender children in youth sports, and urges members of the Texas Senate and the Texas House of Representatives to promote policies that will end all forms of discrimination and work towards a goal of becoming a welcoming and inclusive state for our children.

It is hereby *ORDERED* that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of Commissioners Court this 27th day of April 2021.
