**FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW
ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND
MISSION BEND MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2**

This First Amendment to Agreement for Law Enforcement Services is entered into by and between **Harris County, Texas** (the "County"), acting by and through its governing body, the Harris County Commissioners Court, and **MISSION BEND MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2** (the "District").

RECITALS:

On or about February 12, 2021, the County and the District entered into an Agreement for the provision of law enforcement services on a fee basis in the geographical area represented by the District defined in Exhibit "A" to the Agreement; and

The County and the District desire to amend the Agreement to (i) change the number of deputies patrolling the geographical area from two (2) deputies to three (3) deputies; and (ii) increase the sum the County is to receive by \$60,733.00.

NOW THEREFORE, the County and the District, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, do mutually agree as follows:

TERMS:

**I.
TERM**

1. Section 2.1 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

2.1.A Pursuant to County Attorney File No. 20GEN3077, from March 1, 2020, to February 28, 2021, the Sheriff was authorized to provide two (s) deputies to devote seventy percent (70%) of their working time to provide law enforcement services within the District's geographical area.

2.1.B Beginning on May 8, 2021, and ending on February 28, 2022, unless terminated sooner in accordance with the provisions of Section IV, the County agrees to authorize the Sheriff to provide three (3) deputies to devote seventy percent (70%) of their working time to provide law enforcement services within the District's geographical area as defined in Exhibit "A" of the original Agreement 20GEN3077.

2. Section 3.1 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

For the deputy services indicated in Section 2.1.A and 2.1.B, the District agrees to pay the County the sum of \$209,467.00 for 3 deputy(ies) for a total sum of TWO HUNDRED NINE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$209,467.00) to be used by the County for the purpose of paying seventy percent (70%) of the full-time equivalent cost to the County for supplying the law enforcement services,

including salaries, benefits, vacation, sick leave, and any additional expenses the County may incur in providing the services under this Agreement. Each party paying for the performance of governmental functions or services must make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party.

The District agrees to make payments on the total sum in installments, which are due and payable, without demand, on the following dates in the amounts set forth next to the dates:

The monthly installments are due and payable before 10:00 a.m. at the office of the County Treasurer, 101, P.O. Box 4354, Houston, TX 77210-4354. If the County provides the option, payment may be made by same time and date by electronic means to an account designated by the County.

3. All provisions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the Agreement and this First Amendment, the First Amendment shall control.

4. The County executes this First Amendment to Agreement for Law Enforcement Services by and through the County Judge acting pursuant to the Order of Commissioners Court of Harris County, Texas, so authorizing. This First Amendment to Agreement for Law Enforcement Services shall not become effective until executed by all parties hereto.

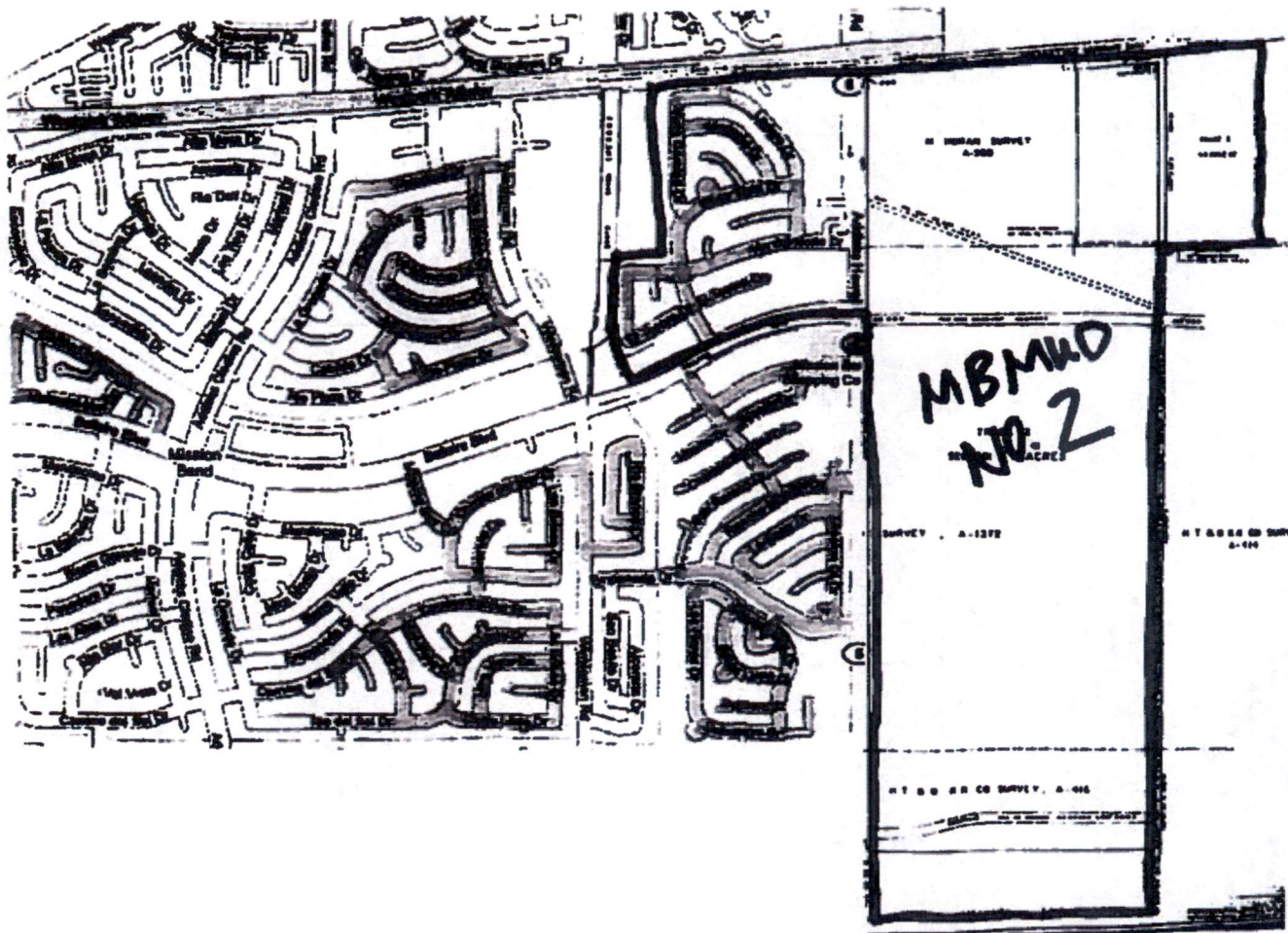
