Respected Colleague- Harris County Constable Precinct 2,

Thank you for the opportunity to work with Harris County Constable Precinct 2. Per your request, Houston K9 Academy, LLC conducted a full evaluation of K9 Hero, February 4, 2021.

1. Physical/ medical evaluation of the K9

- (a) K9 Hero appeared slightly underweight. However, the weight he is at is much more preferred for his breed than being overweight. The K9 was taken for xrays and K9 Hero has a very good bone structure with no signs of dysplasia, arthritis or degenerative change.
- (b) Vaccinations- For Houston K9 Academy to board or take a dog into their facility the canine must be up to date on vaccines. Lt. Kritzler has provided up to date vaccinations.
- (c) Heartworm Prevention-Monthly heartworm prevention is highly recommended for canines in the Texas area due to greater chances of heartworm disease
- 2. K9 Work Evaluation

K9 Hero was taken into the detection room. The canine showed environmental stability, social, toy possession, desire to hunt, controlled aggression on decoy and good civil.

3. Obedience evaluation

Houston K9 Academy does not stress obedience but K9 Hero seems experienced in basic obedience.

HK9A highly recommends K9 Hero for police work and capable for dual purpose narcotic detection (patrol, tracking and detection).

We look forward to our growing relationship with Harris County Constable Precinct 2 and as always are a phone call away for questions or concerns.
