#### **Grant Description:**

Funded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security via the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division, the Homeland Security Grant Program is comprised of three interconnected grant programs: the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI), and Operation Stonegarden. The UASI program addresses the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density urban areas, and assists them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.

Per Congressional mandate, 25% of Homeland Security Grant Program funding must be spent on Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities (LETPA).
