THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HARRIS COUNTY AND GREATER HOUSTON HEALTH CONNECT

THE STATE OF TEXAS §

COUNTY OF HARRIS §

This Third Amendment to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between Harris County (the "County"), acting through its Community Services Department (the "Department") and Greater Houston Healthconnect ("Contractor"). The County and the Contractor are referred to herein collectively as "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

Recitals

On June 28, 2016, , the County and the Contractor entered into a Master Agreement (the "Agreement") to provide non-emergency alternate transportation services to the elderly, disabled and low-income residents of Harris County who are unable to access alternate transportation for medical trips, work trips, and other essential needs trips to remain independent in the community (the "Services").

On July 17, 2017, the Parties amended the Agreement for the first time ("First Amendment") to include budget estimates for each renewal term.

On November 13, 2018, the Parties amended the Agreement for a second time ("Second Amendment") to modify the budget estimates for each of the renewal terms.

The Parties desire to amend the Agreement for the third time ("Third Amendment") for the purpose of extending the agreement and amending the budget estimates.

Terms

I.

This Third Amendment shall be governed by the Master Agreement and previous amendments, which are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth word for word.

II.

The Parties agree to add two, consecutive one-year renewal periods to the Master Agreement (Fifth and Sixth Renewal Terms).

III.

For the two additional renewal terms, Section 2.4 is hereby revised to add the following budget

estimates:

Fifth Renewal Term: \$114,296.00 Sixth Renewal Term: \$141,009.00

IV.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the Master Agreement and Third Amendment are incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment, or any portion thereof, and the terms and provisions of any other part or portion of the Master Agreement, First Amendment, Second Amendment, or any other terms and conditions, this Third Amendment shall control.

V.

Execution. Multiple Counterparts: This Third Amendment may be executed in several counterparts. Each counterpart is deemed an original. All counterparts together constitute one and the same instrument. Each Party warrants that the undersigned is a duly authorized representative with the power to execute this Third Amendment.
