Request by Community Services for authorization to extend the end date to October 31, 2021 for the PY2020 Homeless Youth Services Program.

Background and Discussion:

On February 25, 2020, Commissioners Court approved Harris County Community Services Department's (HCCSD) request to apply for Homeless Housing and Services Program Youth-set- aside (HHSP) funding to provide housing stability case management services to 35 eligible youth headed households for a period of 5 months beginning April 1, 2020 and ending on August 31, 2020. Then on March 24, 2020, Commissioners Court approved the acceptance of a grant award from Child Care Council of Greater Houston, Inc. in the amount of \$199,141 to provide housing case management to 70 eligible youth headed households during the grant period of April 1, 2020 through August 31, 2020. Then on August 10, 2020, HCCSD received notification from the Child Care Council that HCCSD's PY2020 HHSP program was extended to November 30, 2020 for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households and expend any remaining funds. Commissioner Court approved the grant extension on August 25, 2020. Subsequently, on October 28, 2020, HCCSD received notification from the City of Houston that HCCSD was awarded \$266,962 for the extension of the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program (formerly referred to as HHSP-Homeless Prevention and Youth Services Case Management Program) beginning on December 15, 2020 and ending on August 31, 2021 for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households. Then on Commissioners Court approved the acceptance of the additional award of \$266,962 and an extension to the grant term with the City of Houston for the PY2020 HYSP program for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to 60 eligible youth headed households. Finally, on August 19, 2021, HCCSD received notification from the City of Houston that the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program was extended to October 31, 2021.

An extension to the current grant period, ending on August 31, 2021 to October 31, 2021, will allow HCCSD to continue providing housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households and expend remaining funds.

Expected Impact:

Approval to extend the grant term for the FY2020 HYSP program funded by the City of Houston will allow HCCSD to expend remaining PY2020 HYSP program funds.

Child Care Council of Greater Houston, Inc. Homeless Youth Services Program – Grant Extension

On February 25, 2020, Commissioners Court approved Harris County Community Services Department's (HCCSD) request to apply for Homeless Housing and Services Program Youth-set-aside (HHSP) funding to provide housing stability case management services to 35 eligible youth headed households for a period of 5 months beginning April 1, 2020 and ending on August 31, 2020.

On March 24, 2020, Commissioners Court approved the acceptance of a grant award from Child Care Council of Greater Houston, Inc. in the amount of \$199,141 to provide housing case management to 70 eligible youth headed households during the grant period of April 1, 2020 through August 31, 2020. Then on August 10, 2020, HCCSD received notification from the Child Care Council that HCCSD's PY2020 HHSP program was extended to November 30, 2020 for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households and expend any remaining funds. Commissioner Court approved the grant extension on August 25, 2020.

On October 28, 2020, HCCSD received notification from the City of Houston that HCCSD was awarded \$266,962 for the extension of the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program (formerly referred to as HHSP-Homeless Prevention and Youth Services Case Management Program) beginning on December 15, 2020 and ending on August 31, 2021 for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households.

On December 1, 2020, Commissioners Court approved the acceptance of the additional award of \$266,962 and an extension to the grant term with the City of Houston for the PY2020 HYSP program for the purpose of continuing to provide housing stability case management services to 60 eligible youth headed households.

On August 19, 2021, HCCSD received notification from the City of Houston that the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program was extended to October 31, 2021. An extension to the current grant period, originally ending on August 31, 2021 to October 31, 2021, will allow HCCSD to continue providing housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households and expend remaining funds.

It is recommended that Commissioners Court approve and accept the extension to the grant period by two (2) months, from August 31, 2021 to October 31, 2021 for the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program grant for the purpose of continuing to provide housing case management to eligible youth headed households.

An extension to the current grant period, originally ending on August 31, 2021 to October 31, 2021, will allow HCCSD to continue providing housing stability case management services to eligible youth headed households and expend remaining funds; and

WHEREAS, now HCCSD requests authorization to accept the extension to the grant period by two (2) months, from August 31, 2021 to October 31, 2021 for the PY2020 HYSP-Homeless Youth Services Program grant for the purpose of continuing to provide housing case management to eligible youth headed households.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The recitals set forth in this order are true and correct.

Section 2: The Executive Director of the Harris County Community

Services Department or her designee is authorized to accept and execute an agreement extension and any amendments with the City of Houston related to the Homeless Youth

Services Program (HYSP).
