## AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered into by Harris County Community Services Department ("CSD"), and the Office of the County Engineer ("OCE"). These entities agree to abide by the terms and provisions of this Amendment. CSD and OCE are referred to herein collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

## Recitals

On February 25, 2020, CSD entered into an Memorandum of Understanding with OCE to fund administrative, activity delivery, and other grant eligible costs incurred by OCE for infrastructure projects, as well as, establish an accounting and reporting process to reimburse OCE for its employees in supporting CDBG-DR grants administered by CSD for Harris County (the "Master Agreement").

CSD and OCE now desire to amend the Master Agreement to update the terms.

## **Terms**

I.

The project chart included in Section D. 2. entitled "CSD RESPONSIBILITIES" is amended to read as follows:
