Request for approval to negotiate with Ninyo & Moore for Professional Engineering Services for construction materials testing lab and inspection services for Drainage and Road Improvements in the Tall Pines Addition Subdivision for Harris County, Precinct 3.

Background and Discussion:

Asphalt roadway, storm water utilities, and roadway ditch regrading throughout the Tall Pines addition subdivision.

Expected Impact:

Repairing these roadways, installing storm water utilities, and regrading roadside ditches will improve pavement conditions and enhance drainage capacity, thereby improving mobility and safety for all road users and flood resiliency for all adjacent properties. This purchase order will allow the firm to conduct field and laboratory testing on soil, concrete, asphalt and various other construction materials. This testing will ensure the material’s compliance with Harris County Engineering and other governing bodies specifications as required by state law.

Alternative Options:

Construction materials testing is required by state law. Thus, alternatives include issuing a purchase order for similar services to a different vendor, or cancelling this construction project.
