The Title V grant supports the provision of dental services to uninsured children and adolescents at our Southeast and Humble dental locations.

Without these funds, many of the recipients served by this grant would not have access to dental care. The funds are used to pay salaries, procure needed supplies, maintain software and cover service visits for

equipment maintenance.
