**Purpose and Request:**

Recommendation to execute the first amendment to the City of Houston Mason Park Right of Entry agreement for construction and maintenance of channel improvements on Brays Bayou. (Brays Bayou Watershed, Project ID D100-00-00-B047, Agreement No. 2020-140, Precinct 2).

**Background and Discussion:**

This right of entry from the City of Houston will allow the Flood Control District's contractor better access to construct the new South 75<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over Brays Bayou and associated channel improvements. Park property covers three of the four corners of the property where the bridge crosses the bayou.
