Background and Discussion:

The Harris County Inmate Processing Center (IPC) at 1201 Commerce Street is a three-story building that currently houses storage and staff offices. The 43,668 square foot building is a concrete structure with a brick exterior. The building has existing tunnels and bridges connecting the facility to the 1200 Baker Street Jail and extends across Commerce to the Criminal Justice Center. The building is considered an option for renovation to create a medical facility for inmates, as a part of larger effort to repair and
