Request by the Constable of Precinct 5 for approval to submit an application to the Texas Department of Transportation for grant funds in the amount of \$29,869, with a required match of \$7,594, for the FY 2022 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program-Impaired Driving Mobilization Program.

Background and Discussion:

Officers participating in the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) will make enforcement of impaired driving their top priority. Enforcement will occur during the following holiday periods: Christmas/New Year's, Spring Break, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. The goal is to reduce crashes, fatalities, and injuries, through high visibility enforcement and public education.

Expected Impact:

A reduction in crashes, fatalities, and injuries related to impaired driving is expected.

No known viable alternative to accomplish the goal of reducing crashes, fatalities, and injuries with grant funded overtime.
