Harris County Attorney investigate HR issues within the Election Administrator's office.

Background and Discussion:

On March 1, 2022 the Primary Election in Harris County had many irregularities and problems that caused a significant number of voters to lose confidence in the election. These include:

- HarrisVotes.com was down the morning of March 1st, creating confusion of where to vote
- Election equipment malfunctions, including unlocked ballot boxes and issues with scanning the ballots
- The Elections Administrator did not finish the count until roughly 12:30 a.m. on March 3rd, the longest in recent history
- The early vote was not reported by the 7 p.m. deadline on March 1st
- Lack of training for elections staff (per EA precinct judges received 4 hours of training)
- Reports of voters being told they could not vote in their party primary
- Dangerous press communications including false statements by EA Longoria, including claims that parties were "stealing each other's ballot boxes" and "there's no damaged ballots"

Expected Impact:

Improve the operations of our county elections and improving faith in our elections system

Alternative Options:

Have a potentially catastrophic 2022 general election in November, and diminish trust in our elections
