Request for approval to negotiate with Traf-IQ, Inc. for Professional Engineering Services in connection with Intersection Improvement - Telge Road at US 290 - 2022, UPIN 23103MF2R101, Precinct 3.

Background and Discussion:

Telge Road is a 4-lane divided concrete boulevard with curb and gutter cross-section. Telge Road intersects the US 290 Frontage Road to the north and south. There is an existing dedicated southbound left turn lane, shared thru-left, and thru lane at the intersection. The posted speed limit is 40 MPH. The existing intersection experiences significant congestion during morning and evening peak hours.

The project will address traffic volumes and improve the overall safety of the intersection.
