Background and Discussion:

The June 14, 2022 Commissioners Court approved the negotiation with EPIC Transportation Group, LP to help implement the All-Electronic Tolling program. The Toll Road Authority (TRA) intends to enlist the professional services of qualified engineers to provide engineering and planning services required to study corridor and area-wide travel demand, including traffic forecasting and origin-destination analysis and system operations analysis. The work to be performed by the engineers consists of current and future travel demand for proposed improvements related to the Hardy Toll Road Segment #9, in Harris County.
