#### **Background and Discussion:**

As part of the implementation of the All-Electronic Tolling program, the Harris County Toll Road Authority intends to procure the professional services of qualified engineers to provide engineering and planning services.

The May 24, 2022 Commissioners Court approved the negotiation with IDCUS, Inc. to provide engineering services for schematic design related to the Hardy Toll Road Segment #9 - Hardy Toll Road North, in Harris

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County.

The professional service contract will permit HCTRA to support the system planning, engineering, sustainability, tolling, and development of business rules for the conversion to All-Electronic Tolling.
