#### Request Summary (Agenda Caption):

Request for approval of an agreement with Harris County and Armand Bayou Nature Center for property acquisitions to conserve areas along Armand Bayou, HCFCD Unit B100-00-00. (Armand Bayou Watershed, Bond ID C-44, Project ID B100-00-00-R003, Agreement No. 2022-200, Precinct 2).

Background and Discussion: The proposed interlocal agreement between Harris County Flood Control District, Harris County and the Armand Bayou Nature Center would allow for right-of-way acquisition within the Armand Bayou Watershed for the preservation of the flood way, floodplain and other critical habitat in its natural state. The District is contributing \$2 million in funds from the 2018 Harris County Flood Control bond election and \$3 million from the State of Texas Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities and Revived Economies of the Gulf Cost State (RESTORE) Act. The County is contributing \$4.4 million from the U.S. Department of Interior Gulf of Mexico Energy Security (2006) (GOMESA) Act. The Armand Bayou Nature Center is contributing \$1.94 million in funds.

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**Expected Impact:** Acquisition of these parcels will preserve the floodplain in its current natural condition, preserve the natural function of the floodplain, and prevent any future development of the floodplain.

**Alternative Options:** No action, the tracts will remain in private ownership with possible future development.
