Purpose and Request:

Recommendation to execute an agreement in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 with a partial encumbrance of \$100, for professional services with Aviles Engineering Corporation to provide materials engineering and testing services in support of bond and capital improvement projects. (Agreement No. 2022-17, Countywide).

Background and Discussion:

The purpose of this construction materials testing agreement is to provide support for smaller maintenance and capital improvement projects countywide. It allows the Flood Control District to work more efficiently to have an on-call resource as opposed to negotiating an agreement for every single project, even if the project is very small.
