Subject: First Amendment to Right of Entry Agreement with City of Houston at Gus Wortham Park and Golf Course

Purpose and Request:

Recommendation to execute the first amendment to the City of Houston Gus Wortham Park and Golf Course Right of Entry agreement for construction and maintenance of channel improvements on Brays Bayou. (Brays Bayou Watershed, Project ID D100-00-00-B047, Agreement No. 2020-141, Precinct 2).

Background and Discussion:

This right of entry from the City of Houston will allow the Flood Control District's contractor better access to construct the new Lawndale Street bridge over Brays Bayou and associated channel improvements. Park property covers a portion of the site where the bridge crosses the bayou.
