Subject: Agreement with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 238

Purpose and Request:

Recommendation to execute an interlocal mowing reimbursement agreement with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 238 for mowing HCFCD Unit U101-01-00 for a term of five mowing seasons. Funds are available in the amount of \$36,531 for five mowing seasons. (Addicks Reservoir Watershed, Project ID U101-01-00-V004, Agreement No. 1403, Precinct 3).

Background and Discussion:

The Flood Control District mows three times per year. From time to time, other agencies, such as municipal utility districts, would like to mow areas that the Flood Control District mows more frequently. The Flood Control District uses these types of agreements to commit the local agency to maintaining the channel and/or basin and agrees to pay the local agency the amount of funding the Flood Control District would have paid to mow the areas.

Fiscal Impact: Funding of \$36,531 is available as part of the Districts Operations and Maintenance Budget.
