Request Summary (Agenda Caption):

Request by the Office of the Purchasing Agent for approval of an award on the basis of lowest priced proposal meeting requirements and that the County Judge execute an agreement with Elite Research, LLC for program evaluation of grant strategies for Public Health Services for the period of May 16, 2023 - October 16, 2024 (220332), MWDBE Contracted Goal: 13%.

Background and Discussion:

On May 27, 2021, Harris County Public Health (HCPH) was awarded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) the Harris Cares: Embrace HOPE (Healing, Opportunity, Prosperity, and Equity) grant to prevent and control COVID-19 infection (or transmission) among populations at higher risk for COVID-19 and that are underserved, with a focus on racial and ethnic populations and rural communities. The Program Evaluation project will provide evaluation services for the CDC-funded "Harris Cares: Embrace HOPE (Healing, Opportunity, Prosperity, Equity) project for Harris County beginning approximately May 16, 2023.

The Program Evaluation project will create an evaluation plan and subsequent reports detailing key data collection and statistical analysis findings.
